The End of the Rainbow Foundation will relieve poverty by providing basic supplies to persons of low income, especially for those with diverse SOGIE needs, by assisting in finding shelter for those that may be homeless or near homeless, and by providing one-to-one support that will provide advice and referrals to other similar programs to relieve poverty.

It will ease or alleviate poverty through the provision of the necessities of life, especially to SOGIE ethnocultural communities who are poor. It may provide access to the amenities of life that most people take for granted, especially for those facing exclusion because of poverty.

The end of the Rainbow Foundation will help provide employment assistance with members of the community who are living below the poverty line. It will help immigrants that are poor, considered hard-to-employ, specifically refugees, or where the members of the group to be served are living below the poverty line.

Providing basic supplies and the necessities of life. The Foundation will work one-to-one with its clients to match them with volunteers who can provide basic supplies and thus ensure their healthy and sustained independent living. This includes finding or arranging access to food, clothing, medicine and health care, and household supplies to sustain them.

Finding shelter. The Foundation will work one-to-one with its clients to match them with volunteers to find and arrange for homes, apartments, or other acceptable shelter that will sustain them and their family.

Employment assistance. The Foundation will work one-to-one with its clients to match them with volunteers to help them with employment preparation and assistance, such as to prepare resumes, learn or practice interview techniques, search for jobs, prepare for Canadian job expectations, and to help them match their skills to employer needs and expectations.
